



## INVITATION to the Joint CALLIOPE - CALlepSO Workshops

Thursday and Friday, September 2-3, 2010

The epSOS project has delivered its specification work on patient summaries and ePrescription and is now in the process of preparing for testing and implementation. At the same time, Member States are discussing and finalizing the national agreements with organizations that will participate in the pilot as National Contact Points or health service providers in preparation of the pilot to be launched early 2011.

The **objectives of this workshop** are to:

- (i) Provide an opportunity for **consultation** of epSOS task leaders with EU stakeholders, particularly those which represent users (such as health professional groups and patient organisations) on key aspects of legal and ethical challenges addressed in epSOS as well as challenges concerning the evaluation of this Large Scale Pilot
- (ii) **facilitate** a timely **integration** of epSOS experiences **into** the work performed by the CALLIOPE, mainly the proposal for an **EU eHealth interoperability Road Map** and recommendations for its implementation

The set of meetings that takes place in this workshop is addressed to the full membership of the CALLIOPE Network, other CALLIOPE invited visitors, and epSOS leaders. Experts from other relevant projects are also invited. The workshop is organised around three main thematic sessions.

- The **first day** will be allocated to the CALlepSO workshops, which will focus on two thematic areas: **legal/ethical issues for cross border care and Evaluation of the Large Scale Pilot.**

There have been two more occasions in the past, where the epSOS legal issues concerning the epSOS National Contact and the Framework Agreement (including patient consent) have been discussed. The objective of this **morning session** is to focus deeper on specific challenges that concern on one hand on the challenges of dealing with the different security levels in MS and with the ethical challenges of professional practice in the cross border context.

**The afternoon session** will probe into the evaluation framework and plan for epSOS.

*Both sessions should provide important input into the discussions towards the EU eHealth Interoperability Roadmap.*

The Roadmap is an iterative process for open and transparent process for setting priorities and specifying needed actions to be taken at EU level to support the national implementations. Its next version will be delivered on November 30th, 2010.

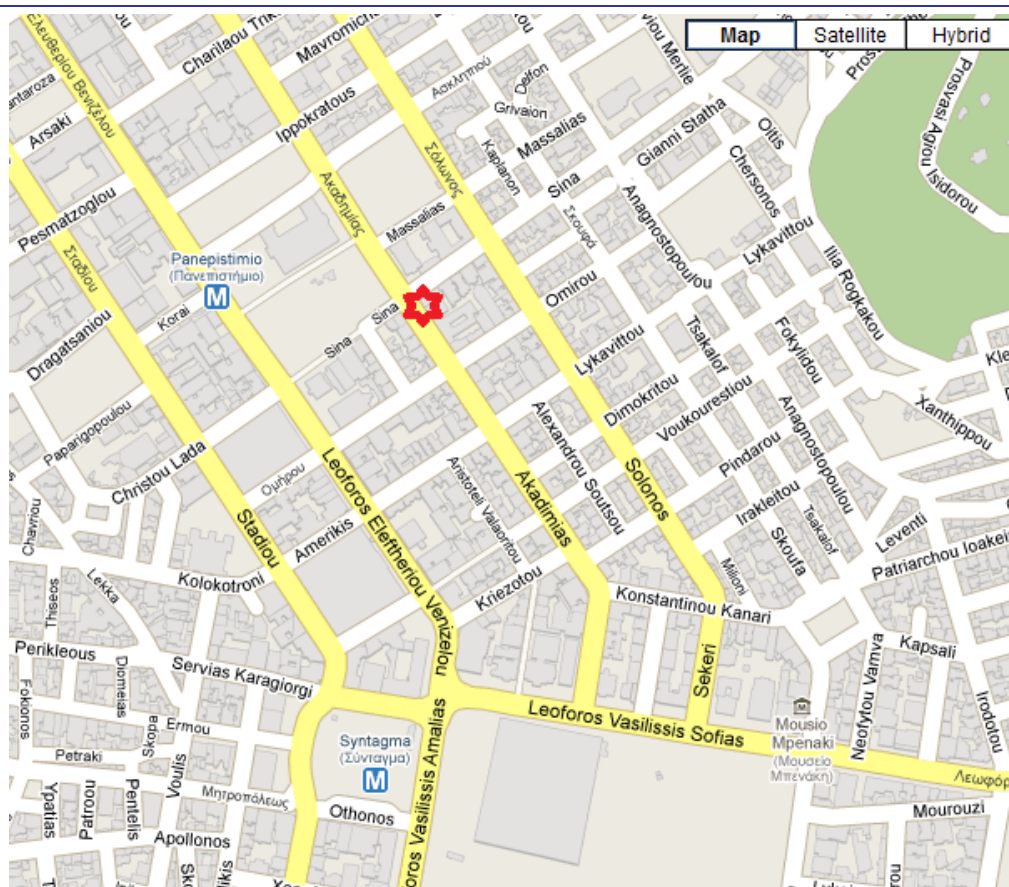
- The **2<sup>nd</sup> day** is dedicated to a full day consultation on the draft version of the **2<sup>nd</sup> iteration of the Roadmap.**
