to the Joint CALLIOPE - CALlepSO Workshops

Thursday and Friday, February 11-12, 2010

Brussels

The epSOS project has concluded a large part of its specification work on patient summaries and ePrescription and is now preparing the testing and implementation work, set to begin in late 2010. Through the CALlepSO collaboration, CALLIOPE is supporting this process by providing a European platform for open dialogue and strategic collaborations with relevant stakeholders to further advance the development and deployment of interoperable eHealth services. Together, they should provide for the elaboration a European eHealth Roadmap, specifying priorities and needed actions to be taken at EU level to support the national implementations.

The objectives of this workshop are to:

- (i) Provide an opportunity for consultation of epSOS task leaders with EU stakeholders, particularly those which represent users (such as health professional groups and patient organisations) on key aspects of the epSOS overall concept and its associated specification, testing and implementation of proof of concept system;
- (ii) facilitate a timely integration of epSOS experiences into the work performed by the CALLIOPE, mainly the proposal for an EU interoperability Road Map and recommendations for its implementation;
- (iii) involve European national Ministries and their Competence Centres not participating in epSOS and interactively inform them about epSOS developments and ensure their effective follow up and involvement.

The set of meetings that takes place in this workshop is addressed to the full membership of the CALLIOPE Network, other CALLIOPE invited visitors, and epSOS leaders. Experts from other relevant projects are also invited. The workshop is organised around four main thematic sessions.

Day 1 is allocated to a presentation of the epSOS business use cases, the epSOS technical specification, and the proposed approach to the testing and implementation of the proof of concept system. An in depth discussion will be pursued through parallel break-out sessions. This enables a sharper focus on specific technical, organisational, and professional issues.

The morning session of day 2 will be discussion and review of the consolidated report that summarises the results of the survey of MS responses to the EC Recommendation of 2nd July 2008 on cross-border interoperability of electronic health record systems (COM(2008)3282 final) and will invite CALLIOPE participants to formulate policy recommendations for the Roadmap activity and concrete proposals for future activities on good practice exchange and implementation support of the Interoperability Roadmap.

The afternoon Session of day 2 will be devoted to a discussion on the EU eHealth Interoperability Roadmap. The discussion will focus on a critical review of the proposal for a shared vision, objectives, proposed structure and content as well as a framework for a given future and for making that future happen, with the aim to release an accepted version for the next High Level EU eHealth Governance Group meeting, in Barcelona in March 2010.

A plenary reporting session with a general exchange and reflections will follow.

We look forward to welcoming you to Brussels.

The work on the functional specifications of epSOS cross-border Patient Summary and ePrescribing Services has concluded. The technical specifications of epSOS architecture, common components, semantic services, identity and authentication services are ready for presentation. The quality control process has started. National Authorities and Competence Centres are checking, if the specified epSOS services meet their requirements and are ready to be implemented and to be adapted to the national infrastructures. The specification of the epSOS Security Services is still ongoing.

The first part of the Workshop in the morning and early afternoon will provide an in depth overview and introduction to the functional and technical specifications for epSOS services (the semantic services were already presented in a CALLeP SO Workshop on January 27, 2010).

The second part in the afternoon is dedicated to exploring ways and means on how to further improve cooperation and exchange among the various stakeholder groups involved .in present and future epSOS and CALLIOPE activities.

All presenters are requested to reserve at least 1/3 of their respective time slot for discussion.

This workshop targets all members of epSOS and CALLIOPE including stakeholders and industry who want to learn about the outcome of the epSOS work on functional and technical specifications.

Furthermore, the members and the coordinators of the national epSOS pilot implementation and operation teams are invited to participate.

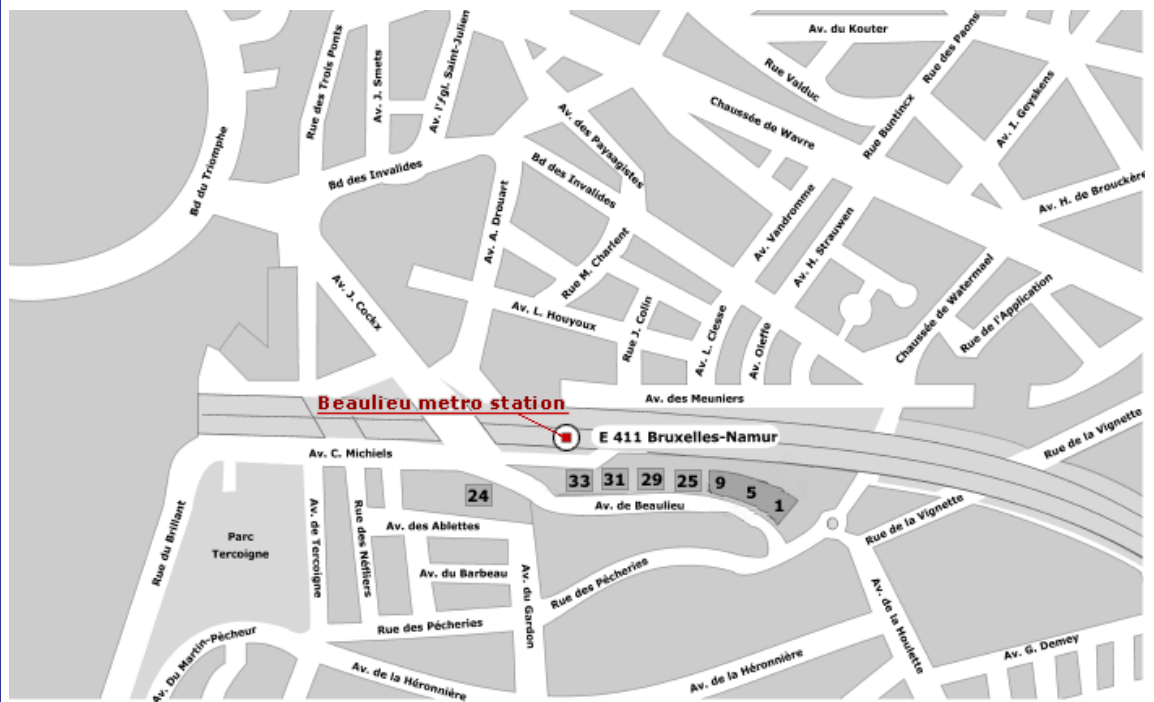
